SPRINGFIELD — Dr. Satyanarayan Motilal Somani, 65, of Springfield died Tuesday, Oct. 29, 2002, at Memorial Medical Center.

He was born March 14, 1937, in Hingoli, India, the son of Motilal and Tulsabai Somani. He married Shipra Dutta in 1966 in Pittsburgh.

Dr. Somani was a professor of pharmacology at Southern Illinois University School of Medicine. He was a member of American Society for Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics, Society of Toxicology, American Chemical Society, International Union of Pharmacology, Association of Scientists of Indian Origin in America and India Association of Springfield.
